

**MILWAUKEE'S CENTRAL PARK  
PHOTOGRAPHY CONTEST

The Milwaukee River corridor between North Avenue and Silver Spring Drive is the focus of an effort to create what is being billed as “Milwaukee’s Central Park.” Three local organizations have joined forces in this endeavor: The Urban Ecology Center, Friends of Milwaukee’s Rivers, and the River Revitalization Foundation. Together they form the Milwaukee River Work Group, an organization whose vision is to preserve the wild aspect of the river corridor, improve water quality and public access, and create a “viewshed” that would regulate development within sight of the river. The Urban Ecology Center Photo Club sponsored this contest in order to encourage photographers to visit the area and to make more people aware of the issue.
